Lenten Services will be each week at both churches.


Lenten Theme will be the Beattitudes from Jesus' only recorded sermon in the bible.

Greetings in the Name of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Our up-coming Lenten worship services, 5:00 at Augustana and 7:00 at Eksjo will center around The Sermon on the Mount. We mainly remember them as the Beatitudes. Jesus tells us that God blesses us even when we are in a "bad place." Our Lenten worship explores what it means for us to be blessed by God in times and places in which the world sees as bad.

Lent encourages us to look at how the world rejects its creator. It encourages us to be aware of the grace of God. Life offers wonder filled moment after wonder filled moment

until we reach the mystery of the end. Lent helps us spot the wonder in every moment. For God is here and God can be seen through the cracks of our existence. The shared laugh of loved ones, the unspeakable compassionate silence in the face of sadness...

During Lent, I hope we can put the finishing touches on a new arrangement between Augustana and Eksjo. For over ten years, we have been in an arrangement originally designed for multiple participating churches but now only have two churches. Eksjo and Augustana are looking at an arrangement where Augustana would contract with Eksjo for ministry expenses. Many of us are used to the idea of a "parish" where multiple churches are under one umbrella organization, but churches are moving away from that idea. Contracts allow member churches more flexibility in making arrangements with each other and entail less financial risk for individual churches. A "parish arrangement" makes it considerably more difficult for individual churches to leave. Member churches of "parishes" are financially responsible even if they no longer have money/members to support the parish. Contracts can be changed to respond to changing circumstances, parishes not as easily.

For most of us, we will not see a difference in how we are. Myself, the pastor, will continue to fulfill all the pastoral duties and even though Augustana is considerable smaller than Eksjo, and contributes a great deal less than Eksjo to the costs of ministry, it will receive the same level of pastoral services it has been receiving. In an ideal world, the amount each church contributes to the costs of ministry, reflects the anticipated work load that each church requires. Practically, we know that there will be some weeks where one church or the other will get the lion's share of the pastor's time. The most important thing to remember is that this is not only a business arrangement. It is a relationship built up for over ten years.

Augustana Church Meeting Minutes · December 10, 2024 · Approved

The meeting was opened by President Marlys Skogmo.

Secretaries Report: John Osborne / The minutes were read by John. Motion made by Arden to approve, Alex seconded, carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kathy M / Kathy handed out the monthly treasurer's report. We are approximately -\$4,700 year to date in our accounts, this is a slightly higher loss than average for this time of year. However, we should have a credit in the LAMP account because the Interim pastor's compensation is lower than Pastor Noel's. Overall the congregation is in good shape financially. Marlys brought up that people over 70 can donate directly from their retirement accounts to the church with no tax consequences. Motion to approve made by Alex, seconded Arden, carried.

Pastor's Report: The Bible study has been well received and going well except for weather related cancellations. Augustana Christmas Eve service will be at 5:30 pm.

Social Ministry: Chris Nybo / Donations to the Christmas families has been going well.

Property: Arden Shustad / Nothing new to report.

Worship and Music: Marlys Skogmo / A new music book has been purchased for the organist to replace the old one.

Christian Ed.: Alex Score / The noisy offering has been started again and is going well.

Stewardship and Evangelism: Kathy Michaelson / The letter placed in the bulletin encouraging people to give has had a positive response. Ads have been placed in the Detroit Lakes and Pelican Rapids newspapers showing service times and congregation information. Christmas cards have been sent out from the congregation to individuals who have a tough time making it to Sunday service. Motion made by Arden to approve all reports, seconded Alex, motion carried.

Old Business: LAMP / A letter has been received from Eksjo congregation council giving notice that they are leaving the LAMP parish. Eksjo will terminate their relationship with LAMP on December 31, 2025. Augustansa and Eksjo councils plan to have a joint meeting to discuss if the two congregations can work together after Eksjo leaves LAMP, and what that relationship might look like. Bishop Bill Tesh will be invited to the meeting.




