

Augustana / Eksjo LAMP Restructure Meeting Minutes · March 3, 2025 · Approved

This meeting was held at Eksjo church.

The meeting was opened by Melanie Hanson.

Pr. Kirchman read a short devotion, followed by a prayer.

The purpose of this meeting is to present and discuss Augustana congregation council's counter offer to Eksjo council's proposed contractual agreement offer.

Augustana's counter offer was presented to Eksjo council. Most of the explanation of Eksjo council's position was handled by Rob Schwartz, although others did participate. All members of Augustana did participate in the discussion. Eksjo council went through the proposed parish agreement and rejected all changes and additions Augustana council had proposed. The only exception Eksjo offered was that Augustana would receive two seats on the Pastor call committee and Eksjo would receive an unlimited number which would be determined by Eksjo council when the committee was being formed. The call committee would not have decision making power, but would only be able to make a recommendation to Eksjo congregation for the final call vote. Other than that one provision, the new agreement would be contractual. Eksjo would employ the Pastor and administrative assistant, and Augustana would pay a monthly amount of \$3,500 to Eksjo for Pastoral and office services. The contract would be for two years. Eksjo was asked how the \$3,500 service fee was arrived at since Augustana is currently paying about \$3,220 / month under the current LAMP partnership. Rob explained that Eksjo council felt this was a good number based on what Augustana had been paying for the last three years, and that this amount would be locked in for two years. So even though Augustana would be paying much more the first year, there would be no price increase the second year. Rob was asked what would happen after the second year. He replied that Eksjo council would review the expenses at that time and adjust the price to Augustana as they saw fit. There would not be a written out formula, it would simply be based on what the Eksjo council deemed appropriate.

Eksjo was asked about future plans of operation. Rob stated they planned to proceed as follows: 1) both Pastor Kirchman and Dawn the administrative assistant, would need to be terminated from their current positions.2) a call for employment would be extended to Pr. Kirchman to be the permanent Pastor at Eksjo. Synod Bishop Tesh has already been consulted and is ok with this.3) Dawn would be asked to be the administrative assistant for Eksjo church.

In addition, the following items would need to be completed before or shortly after Eksjo leaves LAMP. The treasury would need to be audited, funds dispersed to the two congregations, the LAMP treasury accounts would be closed, the LAMP sign at LAMP office would need to be taken down and a new one installed.

Toward the end of the meeting Eksjo council members said they would write up the proposed contractual agreement and send it to Augustana for approval. Augustana members said they would review it at the next council meeting on March 11, 2025.

Eksjo / Augustana LAMP Restructure Meeting Minutes · March 3, 2025 · Approved 6:30 pm @ Eksjo Lutheran Church

Present: most Council members from Augustana and Eksjo. LAMP members from Eksjo. A few Members from Augustana, Pastor Bob, and Eksjo Youth Director, Cole Wixo.

Pastor Bob opened with devotionals and prayer.

- Mel began discussion with going over changes suggested by Augustana vs the Eksjo proposed contract, Mel discussed the spirit of the document was to establish a contractual agreement rather than continue on with an arrangement that requires increased volunteers and complexity.
- John inquired about why the need to change now, he cited past Eksjo congregations had been part of parish agreements. Rob responded by indicating that change was necessary due to lack of membership to the parish, 3 out of the 5 churches had dropped out since its inception, leaving an additional layer of complexity that is unnecessary, LAMP is not functioning the way it was intended with many aspects of the agreement not being fulfilled. Eksjo has a 72% financial responsibility but with has an equal voice on decisions, 2 Eksjo members are completing different payroll (1 for LAMP and 1 for Eksjo's Youth Director), difficulty locating volunteers to serve on committees such as LAMP, Rob expects by moving to a contractual relationship that it will not change the day to day things that happen at our respective churches but will streamline the administrative processes that each church has been accountable for in the past.
- The group continued on making headway through the rest proposed changes, each side discussed their perspectives and both sides were mostly agreeable to the initial Eksjo contract with a few minor changes.
- Then the topic of having Augustana members participate in Pastor or Operational changes, Eksjo accepted the request to have 2 members from Augustana participate in the Call process. The group then moved into the financial obligations section where both sides felt strongly; then after some discussion about how the financial ratio was calculated under LAMP there was concern from Augustana that the \$3,500 proposed cost was created with no basis, Eksjo shared what Augustana had been paying in recent years (2024: \$3,522, 2025: \$3,233 was cited) and indicated that the number was an average over the past 3 years which seemed reasonable to Eksjo, and the contract would be locked for 2 years starting in 2026 through 2027 Eksjo would be the one shouldering the risks of any potential increases to costs, while Augustana would have a set fee for 2 years. After some discussion it seemed that an agreement was made to accept Eksjo's proposal on the costs.

With no other changes or discussion to be had, members thanked each other for the time on this. Pastor Bob closed with the Lord's prayer.

During our bible study of the book of *Ephesians* at Augustana, we read in the first chapter that we have been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places. 
